Faculty Research Recognition Award Program

Purpose:

This annual program is intended to recognize members of the full-time* College faculty whose distinguished track-record of research contributions conducted while a faculty member in the College over the preceding five year period, have had a significant impact on their field.

Award Criteria:

Peer-reviewed or copyrighted published works conducted primarily at Wayne State University representing original work whose impact is judged to advance a specific area of knowledge. Factors to be used in judging this impact include: local, regional, or national awards recognizing the contribution(s); external citations of the work, as noted, e.g., in Science Citation Index, the press, and other media; and patents, licensing agreements, or other forms of technology transfer emanating from the work.

Grant awards intended to support research will not be considered valid award criteria in themselves.

Nomination Process:

Nominations for the awards may be received from any person in response to an annual solicitation from the Office of the Dean. A broadly representative panel consisting of members of the College Research Committee will review nominations and render selections.

Eligibility of past award recipients:

Past awardees will not be considered for the award in the five years subsequent to receiving the award. The main criteria for consideration following the non-eligibility

period will heavily emphasize the outstanding accomplishments during the period following the first award.

The Award Description:

Each of the three Awards will consist of an unrestricted cash award of \$2,500 provided by the Office of the Dean (deposited to the awardees' R&D account) and an appropriately engraved plaque. Presentation of the awards will be made during the annual College Research Day, followed by brief remarks by the awardees outlining their research.

Focus Areas:

The awards will recognize outstanding researchers in three major areas of study in this college, as listed below:

1. Basic Sciences
2. Clinical Sciences
3. Health and Behavioral Sciences

*For purposes of this award, the term "Full-time College faculty" is intended to include all faculty with appointments in one of the College's departments, who are considered University employees to the extent of at least 0.50 FTE, without regard to funding source(s). It is also intended to include faculty in other units of the University who have tenure or tenure-retreat rights in one of the College's departments. Persons with adjunct appointments in the College are not included.
